2023 Highlights

- EASTER: Our Easter outreach in April saw a huge turnout of people show up for candy, prizes and of course a helicopter. This led to us having two packed services on Sunday with around 30 salvations!
- Vacation Bible School: Not only did we invest in better curriculum this year for Sundays, we also continue to build our VBS program. Reaching kids and families is critical to building Gods kingdom in Tillamook and VBS brings in many families that are unchurched.
- Community Worship Nights: With our new auditorium done we engaged in several worship nights for the community that saw many from our area come to be filled with God's presence and encouraged by His word. We also did this at the Tillamook Coliseum with over 200 in attendance during an amazing night of worship.
- Missions Focus: : One of our purposes as a church body is to reach the lost not just locally but around the world. This year we increased this focus by leading our first church missions trip to Liberia and adding many new missionaries. Along with that we had missionaries visit from Liberia, Nepal, Romania and Georgia.
- Church Plant Work: This year we began the foundational work for our future church plant in Clatsop County. We began building through a community worship night, many meetings with local Christians and engaging local pastors with the vision to reach their county in a greater way.
 - <u>Christmas:</u> Christmas is a great time to reach those far from God and this year we doubled our Christmas Eve service attendance and had many be encouraged and come to know Jesus during this season.


Ukiah & Lacey Hawkins Family & Marriage **Elders & Pastors**








UNIFIED VISION!



Mannahouse Global Network

As we move into 2024 and 2025 we will continue to deliberately build towards our first campus or church plant somewhere in Clatsop County. MHGN is our ministry partner in missions, church planting and equipping our people to build the kingdom. Their goal is to plant 1000 churches on the west coast and build a financial platform to help church plants having funding to do so. Each year we pledge 3% of our tithe towards this network and when we are ready to plant they will be a key partner in launching church plants on the coast with us.

LOCAL OUTREACH



- SINGLE PARENTS CELEBRATION: This event will be supporting and resourcing our single parents with what they need. The cost is about \$500 per parent which could make this event our most expensive event ever done. We are currently seeking grants to support this but we are also asking the church to pledge \$7,000 towards this.
- **VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL:** VBS is always one of our big outreaches to families and always needs significant funding to do it well. The cost for this year's VBS will be around \$5,000. It will make a huge impact on reaching the kids of our community and their families and is one of the reasons our kids ministry continues to grow and thrive.
- LWF MARRIAGE & FAMILY PROGRAMS: Our marriage conference and many other events is another way we reach out to our community. Last year we reached 36 couples and are continuing to lead the way in marriage growth and restoration. Many marriages were encouraged and we believe the root of changing Tillamook County starts in the home and in the marriage relationship. This year our conference will cost \$5,000.
- GENERAL OUTREACH: Our church leads in many outreaches throughout the year and our church is the primary catalyst for all outreach in our county. From Compassion Clinic to Younglife Tillamook to Worship Night at the Fair and many many other local outreach events. Without your generous giving to the vision fund we would not be able to take part in these events. The projected cost this year will be \$5,000 not including the many hours our staff dedicate to these programs whose payroll funding comes out of our general fund.
